

The Industry Development Training (IDT) Schedule is produced for the benefit of the industry and identifies courses that students may wish to attend to start, to develop or broaden their careers in the plumbing industry. To achieve this IDT works with many provider Registered Training Organisations (RTO) who are registered to deliver one or more of the courses. The placement of a student on any course is determined based on various factors including course availability, course dates and RTO location. Any recommendation by IDT is only a recommendation and the learner must satisfy themselves as to the course suitability.

In addition, IDT attempts to identify funding sources, when available, to assist the student. If funding is identified, then IDT will organise the finance and invite the student to apply to the relevant RTO. The student will be enrolled by the RTO following their processes if the learner meets their entry requirements. IDT does not conduct the training and does not charge either the learner or the RTO a fee for the service it provides.

If an RTO is identified with a course in this schedule, then this is only an indication of a provider who is known to regularly provide this training and may not be the preferred option for any applicant. Where the student is required to pay some or all of the fees then they will not be required to pay more than \$1500 in advance at any one time.


